



Volunteer Opportunity: Attorney Advisors for High School Mock Trial

Approximately 800 high school students across North Carolina participate in the NCMTP **High School Mock Trial Competition** each year, taking on the roles of witnesses and attorneys in February (Regional) and March (State Final) competitions. Teams of 7 to 9 students are co-coached by both a teacher coach and a volunteer attorney advisor. Competitions are judged by other practicing attorneys, sitting judges, and other legal professionals.

Need for more Diversity in Access to Programming:

Certain schools tend to participate each year. Diversity and access to programming is important to the North Carolina Mock Trial Program (NCMTP). What the role involves:

We are looking for attorneys who are willing to reach out to their local high school principals and offer to help the schools establish teams. A local teacher coach supports the attorney advisor. Depending on the attorney advisor's availability, meetings with students typically occur 6 to 8 times, virtually or in person, between October and early February.
